



NOTICE

Dated: 14.07.2017

In continuation of this Court's Notice dated 12.07.2017, it is hereby notified that the qualified candidates are directed to send/submit the copies of the following testimonials, duly attested by a Gazetted Officer and original caste/disability certificate to the Joint Registrar (Examination) within 10 days:-

- (1) Proof of age (Certificate of Matriculation or other equivalent examination).
- (2) LL.B. Degree or other equivalent law degree.
- (3) Certificates and degrees of all courses passed or attended commencing from Matriculation Examination onwards.
- (4) Advocate's license if practicing / Proof of enrolment, if enrolled with Bar.
- (5) In case of a candidate who claims to belong to one of the Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, certificate from a Sub-Divisional Officer, Additional District Magistrate, Revenue Assistant or any other officer, who has been designated by the State Government concerned as competent to issue such a certificate.
- (6) In case of a candidate claiming reservation/relaxation on account of being Physically Handicapped (Blind/Low Vision) (mobility not to be restricted)/ Orthopaedically handicapped {OA- one arm affected (right or left), OL-one leg affected (right or left), BL-both legs affected but not arms}}, certificate, issued by a Government Hospital/Medical Board in support of his/her claim.
- (7) In case of a candidate claiming relaxation in age on account of his/her being Ex-Serviceman, Emergency Commissioned Officer or Short Service Commissioned Officer, documentary evidence in this regard.
- (8) A candidate, who claims to belong to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes or Physically Handicapped categories, must submit the original caste/ disability certificate to the Joint Registrar (Examination), Delhi High Court within ten days of the declaration of the result.
