In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 7 of the Delhi High Court Act, 1966 (Act 26 of 1966) read with Sections 122 and 129 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the High Court of Delhi, hereby makes the following amendment in Part A of Chapter 3 of Volume V of the Delhi High Court Rules & Orders:

## **AMENDMENT**

THE FOLLOWING SHALL BE INSERTED AS RULE 8A AFTER THE EXISTING RULE 8 OF PART A OF CHAPTER 3 OF VOLUME V OF THE DELHI HIGH COURT RULES & ORDERS:-

"8A. Party appearing in person — The Court may, in its discretion and after recording its brief reasons, disallow a party from appearing in person.

Provided, in such event the Court will give sufficient time to the party-inperson to be represented by a lawyer of the party's choice or where the party desires to be represented by an Amicus Curiae or legal aid counsel appointed by the Court."
