In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 7 of the Delhi High Court Act, 1966 read with Article 225 of the Constitution of India, Clause 27 of the Letters Patent and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the High Court of Delhi, hereby makes the following amendments in Schedule to Chapter XXIII of Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 1967, namely:-

The following shall be substituted for the existing para A(2) to Schedule (Table of Fees) to Chapter XXIII:-

(2) If the amount or value shall exceed Rs. Five Lakh, on Rs. Five Lakh as above and on the remainder at 1 per cent subject, however, that in no case the amount of fee shall exceed Rs,50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) or the actual, whichever is less, subject to the condition that a certificate of fee must be filed.

Note: This amendment shall come into force immediately on the date of publication in Delhi Gazette.
