**PRACTICE DIRECTIONS**

Hon'ble the Chief Justice has been pleased to issue following Practice Directions for information and compliance by all Criminal Courts :-

1. Before commencement of the trial, every Criminal Court shall prepare a gist of the case.
2. The trial of criminal cases shall be monitored and details of cases shall be recorded in proforma given below :
  - (i) Name of accused
  - (ii) Number of case
  - (iii) Substance of complaints
  - (iv) Number and date of investigation report
  - (v) Period spent on investigation
  - (vi) Reasons for delay, if investigation report is after 60 days of commission of the offence
  - (vii) Offence prima facie found by the police
  - (viii) Offence charged by the Court after police investigation
  - (ix) Commencement of evidence
  - (x) Closure of evidence
  - (xi) Period spent on trial
  - (xii) Reasons for delay in trial if the period spent was more than one month
  - (xiii) Date of judgment
  - (xiv) Reason for delay in judgment if after one month of closure of evidence and
  - (xv) Explanation for delay

These Practice Directions shall come into force immediately.
