Re: Designation of Senior Advocate

In exercise of powers conferred by Section 4 of "The High Court of Delhi Designation of Senior Advocate Rules, 2024', framed in view of Judgment dated 12th May 2023 of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 454 of 2015 titled "Ms. Indira Jaising "Vs. Supreme Court of India through Secretary General & Ors", published in Delhi Gazette Extraordinary, Part II, Section I, No.10 {NCTD No. 475} dated 14.03.2024 (Notification No.18/Rules/DHC dated 14th March, 2024), the 'Committee for Designation of Senior Advocates' invites applications from eligible Advocates for conferment of designation as Senior Advocate.

The eligibility conditions for conferment of 'Senior Advocate' designation are incorporated in the Rule (5) of 'The High Court of Delhi Designation of Senior Advocate Rules, 2024' which are as under:-

No person shall be eligible for being designated as Senior Advocate unless he/she:-

- (i) has practiced as an Advocate at the Bar for not less than 10 years;
- (ii) is enrolled with the Bar Council constituted under the Advocates Act. 1961:
- (iii) has been mainly practicing in the High Court and the Courts Subordinate to it;
- (iv) has appeared and argued cases or provided legal services probono; and
- (v) has attained the age of 40 years, unless the age limit is relaxed by the Permanent Committee.

Note: Applicant/advocates having domain expertise of practicing before specialized Tribunals may be given concession with regard to the extent of appearance in the High Court.

Explanation: The eligibility condition with regard to minimum standing as a practicing Advocate shall not apply to retired Judicial Officers of

Delhi or those who have resigned having service and / or practice of 10 years at their credit.

Note: - The cut-off date for the purpose of minimum age as referred to in sub rule (v) of Rule 5 of "The High Court of Delhi Designation of Senior Advocate Rules, 2024" is 20th March, 2024 i.e. the date of this Notice.

The procedure of conferment of designation as Senior Advocate has been provided in Rule 9 & 10 of the aforementioned Rules.

Therefore, applications (<u>only in soft form</u>) seeking conferment of designation as Senior Advocate are accordingly invited from eligible practicing Advocates as provided in Rule (5) of 'The High Court of Delhi Designation of Senior Advocate Rules, 2024', in the prescribed format i.e. Annexures-A & A1 attached with this notice strictly in accordance with the instructions mentioned therein, latest by 30.04.2024 (5.30 p.m.) at the following mail address:
