- 2. All fresh Execution Petitions including the petitions arising out of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act shall be listed before Judge In-charge (Original Side).
- 3. Hon'ble Judge-in-Charge (Original Side) will distribute fresh Arbitration Matters including Commercials Matters under the Arbitration Act, 1940 and the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 between 'A', 'C', 'D' & 'G' Courts.
