

It is a network comprising of Central Library, Chamber Libraries and Residence Libraries collectively offering an extensive array of rare Indian and Foreign Law Reports, Commentaries, Digests, Text Books, Dictionaries, Local Acts, and Bare Acts.

In addition to its vast resources, the Library also includes an array of **modern** tools & information resources such as Online and CD/DVD ROM Databases, Integrated Library Automation Softwares, and various information retrieval systems. A dedicated "Reading cum Meeting Room" equipped with Wi-Fi and video conferencing facilities, which caters exclusively to the needs of the Hon'ble Judges, fostering an environment conducive to focused research and deliberations.



The Judges' Library at the Delhi High Court has taken a significant step for providing web-information portal, accessible at Delhi High Court's webpage under the head 'e-Library'. This platform serves Current Awareness Services, providing updates on Recent Acquisitions and offering convenient access to multiple legal databases, open-source journals, e-books, and other essential resources to enhance accessibility and facilitating comprehensive legal research for judiciary of this Court.
